Hi. I am interested in making a Chocolatey (<https://chocolatey.org>) package for Image Analyzer, and I am wondering if you would be willing to give your consent to distribute the unaltered installation executable within the Chocolatey package on the public repository.

Many Chocolatey packages download a software installer from the download source, but FossHub (your download host) has asked that Chocolatey not download from their site. If the software license allows or there is express consent, Chocolatey packages can have the binaries "embedded" as a alternative method of distribution and installation.
